We have postponed our two upcoming productions of *Tempting Providence*, which was to open April 23rd, and *This Year Next Year*, previously scheduled for May 28th. If you have purchased a season's pass or individual tickets for these plays, we are pleased to announce that we have moved both plays into our 2020/21 season. We will let you know the dates soon. Tickets for the original runs will be honoured for the rescheduled dates. If you are still interested in seeing the show, please hold on to your tickets.
