#### A Thank You to Craig Greenwood!



## Our Speaker for September: Dr. David Philipp



For over 30 years, Dr. Philipp directed the Fish Genetics and Conservation Laboratory at the Illinois Natural History Survey, a research department within the Prairie Research at the University of Illinois.

His research group has helped to document the negative impacts of outbreeding depression that can result from hatchery stocking programs, as well as to illustrate the evolutionary effects that human impacts can have on natural populations; including how recreational angling affects survival, parental care activities, reproductive success, and annual recruitment of wild fish populations.

As one of the founders of the Fisheries Conservation Foundation, where he serves as Chair of its Board of Directors, Dave works to develop both educational and research-based programs for the conservation and management of fisheries, including projects in Bhutan, Canada, USA, Pakistan, Nepal, Thailand, and The Bahamas.

Dave is currently spearheading projects in Ontario designed to develop innovative conservation strategies for Black Bass.

The Perth Probus Club meets at the Royal Canadian Legion, 26 Beckwith Street, Perth, on the first Wednesday of the month, September through May.

Our June meeting is at an alternate location.
