Brian Preston addresses the Club

Brian Preston, a travelling Sommelier, spoke about a wide variety of topics related to wine. He discussed food pairings (if the food is light, have light wine to start and then escalate). He suggested starting with dry and



moving to sweet, and matching the acidic level of the food and wine. He reminded us of the types of grapes found in Burgundy (Pinot Noir) and Beaujolais (Gamay) wine, and of the importance of aroma and temperature (14-15°C is cellar temperature).

He referred us to the library, and the LCBO website for more information. The session concluded with tasting of five wines.
