



A TRIP ON BIG RIDEAU LAKE

Want to see the many new houses built on the shores of Big Rideau Lake? How has the lake changed? A trip aboard Sue and Dennis Dwyer's diesel-powered Rosborough Sea Skiff is a pleasant way of finding out.

Most trips are about two hour's duration, although longer trips can be arranged if requested. A maximum of 4 passengers per trip makes for comfortable seating and movement aboard. There is no charge for the trip and the skipper only asks that you make a donation to the charity of your choice on the honour system.
